SPIRITUAL REFLECTIONS

Servant of God Thomas Frederick Price – Cofounder, Maryknoll (1860-1919) – Thomas Frederick Price was born in 1860 in North Carolina, the child of Catholic converts. He would become the first Catholic priest ordained in that thoroughly Protestant state, a fact that helped inspire his great zeal for mission. Determined to spread the Catholic faith among his fellow “tar heels” he trudged throughout his native state, door to door, farm to farm, contenting himself to spread the faith one soul at a time.

In 1910 at the Eucharistic Congress in Montreal, he met Fr. James Anthony Walsh, director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in Boston. Together they conceived the idea of founding a mission seminary to recruit and train American priests for overseas mission, particularly in China. At a time when the U.S. had itself only recently emerged from the status of mission territory, this was a bold plan. Nevertheless, in 1911 they received support from the U.S. bishops and from Rome to establish the Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America – popularly known as Maryknoll.

Of the two founders, Price was the more contemplative- “the Mary to Walsh’s Martha” – who cherished a deep devotion to the Blessed Mother and St. Bernadette of Lourdes. He volunteered to China in 1918, though his fragile health was not equal to the challenge. He died there after only a few months, living only to glimpse the first seeds of Maryknoll’s overseas mission.

“If the Catholics in this country but did their duty to both home and foreign missions, a mighty change would take place both in ourselves and in the whole foreign-mission world.” -Fr. Thomas Frederick Price

So Utterly Simple

You go forth as an apostle – with no shoes, no gold or silver. Then, once more, you too will hear the words of Christ at the end of the journey. “Have you wanted for anything?”

Your vocation is simple, so utterly simple, that words fail to describe it. It is intangible, yet very concrete. To burn. To do the will of God in the humble duty of every moment. To die to self through obedience, poverty, love. Through chastity also. To be ready to be crucified, in the mystical sense, on the cross of the will of God. To be ready to be crucified by men and women. You will be crucified by their words, though you may not yet realize that words spoken by men and women are like chaff in the wind. They will be words of disapproval, of doubt, of ridicule. You will also be crucified by gestures (the shrugging of shoulders, for example). You will be crucified by others’ disbelief in your way of life.

Your cross will be very small. It will probably be in the marketplace or where you live. Yes, the cross will be small, as tall as you or I, each according to his size.

Catherine de Hueck Doherty (1896-1985) was a Russian-born aristocrat who dedicated her life to “the gospel without compromise.” Author of numerous books, she established the Madonna House in Combermere, Ontario.
